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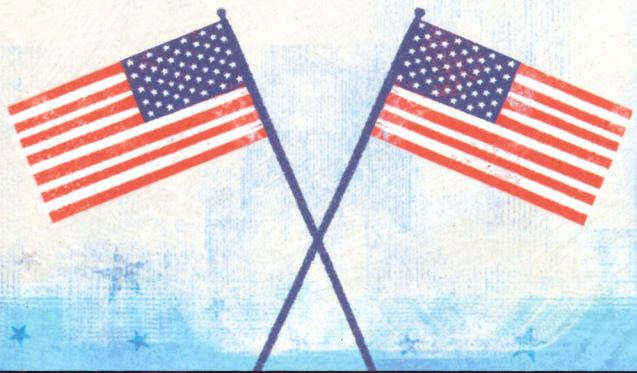

**Re: Replacement of Ambulance**

## **Summary:**

During the 2024 Budget process, the Board adopted a capital plan that included the replacement of one ambulance in 2026. Based on current usage and reliability experience, the replacement schedule for ambulances in our organization is every six years. A new ambulance serves in a frontline status for six years and then it is moved to a reserve status for two years.

The ambulance committee worked with several vendors to get quotes and update our specifications. The committee narrowed the vendor down to two candidates Horton (our current vendor) and Road Rescue. Based on price and the ability to meet our specifications the committee is recommending we purchase from Road Rescue.

The vendor has indicated that the delivery date for the new ambulance would be approximately two years after the order is placed and the vehicle specifications are reviewed and finalized. **Payment is not due until delivery of the ambulance**, which will occur in 2026. If approved at this meeting, the new ambulance is expected to be delivered in May of 2026.

## **Budget:**

The total cost of the project is \$417,051 without the trade in value for one of our current ambulances. The vendor indicated we can expect roughly \$25,000 for trade in when we accept delivery of the new ambulance, but they cannot guarantee that price at this time. The vendor will give us the 2026 fair market value when we take delivery. Based on the trade estimate the cost of the project will be reduced to \$392,051. The quote also includes \$6,100 for an 8-year 150,000-mile warranty on the recommendation from our mechanics. We have not purchased an extended warranty on any of our other ambulances but feel this is a good investment. The Capital Plan contains \$405,000 for a new ambulance in 2026 and is sufficiently funded to support the purchase of a new ambulance.

## **Recommendation:**

Authorize staff to proceed with the ordering of a new ambulance at an estimated cost of \$417,051 without trade in. The ambulance would be purchased from Road Rescue, utilizing our membership in the Savvik Buying Group.
